On Sunday April 27, a group of children were invited to the Dow Corning Zhangjiagang (ZJG) site to attend an environmental class conducted by the site's environmental engineers. Terry Strange, the ZJG site manager, also attended this event and gave a brief welcome speech to the children.

During the class, the children learned a lot regarding environmental protection, including:

- the history of Earth Day
- nature's water cycle
- global water resource management
- how Dow Corning recycles cooling tower water
- the general waste water treatment workflow in Dow Corning



At the end of the class, all the children actively discussed how to avoid wasting water and shared their own family's smart tips with each other.

After the class, all the participants moved to an eco-friendly park. By the lake in this park, several volunteers, mainly from the environment and quality department of ZJG site, led the children in an exercise to perform water quality tests on the lake water.
