Shortly after, he joined the Detroit Police Department and served in a number of positions before his acceptance into the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).

During his 25-year career with the FBI, Kevin worked in a variety of programs including terrorism, counterintelligence, white collar crime, and drug investigations. His two assignments at the FBI's Headquarters included responsibility for both criminal and administrative matters. His final position in Headquarters was as Deputy Assistant Director for Human Resources.

Kevin's final assignment with the FBI was as Special Agent in Charge of the field office in Charlotte, North Carolina. There, he had responsibility for 120 agents, 150 task officers and more than 100 support staff, spanning the three Federal judicial districts within the state. His responsibilities also included leading all crisis management events involving the FBI and liaising with public and private-sector entities throughout North Carolina.
